Rules

- Two participants from each section will be selected by the class teachers which should be submitted to the coordinators by 7th of July. No changes will be made after the submission of names.
- Students can tell a short story of their choice.
- It can be a fairy tale, a folk tale, or an original story.
- The story should be child-friendly and positive.
- Each child will get 2 minutes to tell their story. There will be a warning bell after 1 min 30 sec. and the second bell, informing participants to stop.
- The story should be told by heart (no reading from a paper).
- Use facial expressions, hand movements, and voice changes to make the story fun!
- Costumes or small props are not allowed
- Participants are not allowed to give self-introduction.
- The decision of the judges will be **final**.

Class 2 QUIZ COMPETITION

Topics (from EVS and GK book of class II)

- Our wonderful body
- The food we eat
- Animal kingdom
- Plant kingdom
- Our country(famous, dishes, festivals and clothes)
- MATHS- (addition without carry over, subtraction without borrowing, tables 2 to 8)

Rules

- ➤ The teams will be divided according to class sections. Each team will have two participants selected by the class teachers. Names should be submitted to the coordinators by 7th of July. No changes will be made after the submission of names.
- > There will be three rounds.

> General round

Two questions will be asked from each team. Every question carries 5 marks. Questions will not be carried forward.

> Audio video round

Two questions will be asked in audio/video format from each team. Every question carries 5 marks.

Questions will not be carried forward.

> Maths round

A sheet of ten questions will be provided to each team. Each question carries 1 mark. Students will get only a minute to solve the sheet.

- ➤ In case of a tie, a special **tie-breaker question** will be asked. The first team to answer correctly wins.
- > Teams must wait for the question to be read completely before answering. Only one answer is allowed.
- > Students must be respectful and quiet while others are answering.

Class III Spell Bee Competition

Rules

- Two participants from each section will be selected by the class teachers which should be submitted to the coordinators by 7th of July. No changes will be made after the submission of names.
- Each participant competes individually.
- The pronouncer will say the word clearly and aloud.
- The participant may ask for the word to be **repeated**.
- **The participant must:** Spell the word aloud and say the word again. Example: . A-P-P-L-E. Apple."
- Each participant will have to spell and pronounce correctly maximum words within 45 seconds.
- 50 words will be given to the students prior the competition to prepare. 10 more difficult words will be given a day prior to the competition.
- The decision of the judges will be **final**.

Class IV

DECLAMATION COMPETITION (Language -English)

Rules

- Two participants from each section will be selected by the class teachers which should be submitted to the coordinators by 7th of July. No changes will be made after the submission of names.
- The speech must be of the chosen revolutionary leader delivered on a special occasion.
- Content should be age-appropriate and respectful.
- Each participant will be allowed to speak for 2 minutes only. There will be a warning bell after 1 min 30 sec. and the second bell, informing participants to stop. Marks will be deducted for going over time.
- Participants are encouraged to dress like the revolutionary they are portraying. They can also use props.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Extempore Competition (Language -English)

Rules

- Two participants from each section will be selected by the class teachers which should be submitted to the coordinators by 7th of July. No changes will be made after the submission of names.
- 10 Topics will be given prior to the competition to prepare. Participants will randomly select a chit and deliver a one-minute speech on the given topic. Students will get 1–2 minutes to prepare their speech after receiving the topic.
- A final bell will ring at 1 minute.
- The speech should be **original**, clear, and relevant to the topic.
- Use of personal examples, creativity, and clear structure is encouraged.
- No reading from notes or papers is allowed.
- Use of inappropriate language/content will lead to disqualification.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
